HELPFUL IDEAS TO MAKE YOUR CHAPTER RIDES AS MUCH FUN AND SAFE AS POSSIBLE

1. Arrive at our departure sites 15 to 30 minutes early with a full fuel tank and an empty Bladder so we can leave on time. If the ride takes us through Leesville, we will meet At the parking lot of the vehicle registration office.

2. Open days in the schedule are for any member who wishes to plan a ride on that date.

3. Be flexible, unknown functions and events not listed will be coming up through the year for example, benefit rides, veteran's events and ice cream rides. Remember the ride schedule is your schedule and it's not written in stone. It can change because of the weather or the Chapter decides so. But please do not wait to the last minutes before the scheduled ride and want to change it.

4. Rides - Join Them. Go on as many rides as you can, decide for yourself if you prefer long rides or short rides after all you are the only one who can decide what kind of rides is the most fun for you. Remember you're responsible for your own ride.

5. It is recommended that a good quality helmet, eye protection, boots, full finger gloves and proper seasonal clothing, be worn by all riders and co-riders and that you have verified your Motorcycle / Trike is in a safe operating condition.
